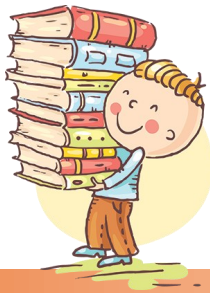
Who are we?

The Georgia Bright Futures Foundation is one of a handful of non-profit organizations that are registered with the Georgia Department of Education and work with the Georgia Department of Revenue to manage scholarship program

According to Georgia Private School Tax Credit law, Georgia tax payers (individuals and businesses) are allowed to redirect their state tax liabilities to fund tuition scholarships for children who desire to attend eligible Georgia private K-12 schools

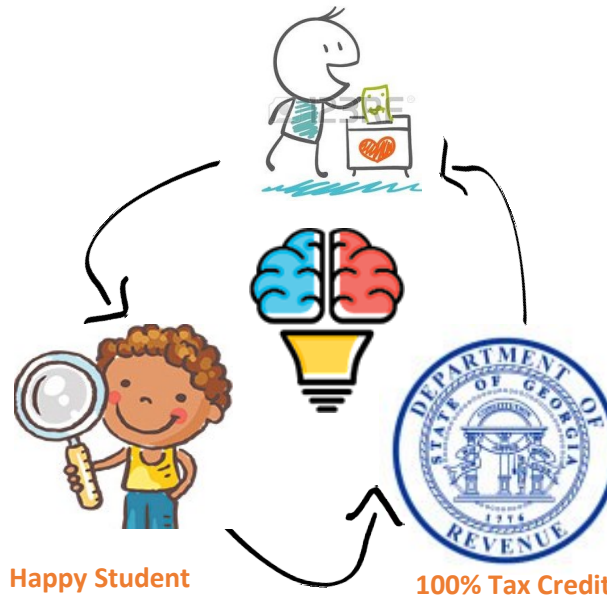
For every dollar that a GA taxpayer (individual & business) donates to this program, they receive a dollar-for-dollar credit.

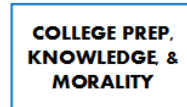

DONATE IN 3 EASY STEPS !

- 1) The Donor completes Georgia Form IT-QEE-TP1 (Pre-Approval Form) on gabright.org
- 2) Once approved, the donor makes a donation via credit card or check (payable to Georgia Bright Futures Foundation).
- 3) Then, the Georgia Bright Futures Foundation issues a receipt which the taxpayer can use on their annual tax returns for a dollar-for-dollar tax credit.
