

MASJID REOPENING

Al-Farooq Masjid of Atlanta is happy to announce that it will officially open for Jumu'ah and 5 daily prayers from Friday, June 05, 2020.

Guidelines

1. Location for Five Daily Salahs and Jumu'ah Prayer

Five daily Salahs will be held in the inside part of the lobby while Jumu'ah Salahs will be performed in the inside and outside parts of the lobby.

2. Time for Two Jumu'ah Salahs and Five Daily Prayers.

There will be two Jumu'ah Salahs: 1st at 2 pm and 2nd at 3:15 pm. Jama'ah for Five Daily Salahs will held according to Al-Farooq Masjid Salah Schedule which can be obtained from Masjid's website.

3. Masjid will remain Open for a limited time for each Salah.

Please perform all your Sunnah and Nafl prayers at home. Masjid doors will be unlocked 5 minutes before the Fard salah and will be locked back again 5 minutes after the congregational prayer.

4. Make Wudu and Use Restroom at Home.

Please use restroom and make Wudu at home. Masjid restrooms and Wudu areas will remain closed.

5. Personal Prayer Rug is Mandatory.

Every person must bring their own prayer rug for each prayer when coming to the Masjid.

6. Face Mask and gloves are Mandatory.

Everyone must wear face mask and gloves at all times while on the property of the Masjid in order to attend the congregation inside or outside. The mask must cover both the mouth and the nose.

7. Elderly and Children are highly advised to stay home.

Children under 10 and elderly above 65 or with pre-existing conditions are highly advised to stay home.

8. Stay home if You are Sick or have Symptoms

If you are unwell or have COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, cough, difficulty in breathing and fatigue or if a member of your family was diagnosed positive with COVID-19, please stay home to protect yourself and others.

9. Maintain Social Distance of 6 feet, no Handshaking or Hugging

Everyone must maintain social distance of at least 6 feet from one another at all times. Please place your rugs on the marked signs only. Handshaking and hugging will not be advised.
